General Information for Visiting Teams

Directions to Willamette University

Take I-5 Exit 253 and drive west on Mission Ave. From the top of the overpass it is 2.2 miles to the Willamette University/City Center off-ramp. Once you take the off-ramp, you can see the Willamette soccer field and the Lestle J. Sparks Center. Follow the signs to Willamette and get into the right-hand lane at the light. Once you have progressed through the intersection, take the next available right onto campus.

Parking

Visitor Parking for athletic events is as follows:

- **Football, Baseball, Track & Field, & Cross Country (McCulloch Stadium, Keene Stadium, Charles Bowles Track, & Bush Park):** Main Parking Lot: Take I-5 Exit 253 and drive west on Mission Ave. From the top of the overpass it is 2.7 miles to the entrance of the park, which is on the left. **Other Parking:** From Mission take 12th Street, then a right onto Cross Street. There will be parking on the right by a softball field. The main campus is also in walking distance to the stadium (Directions found under Basketball).
- **Basketball, Volleyball, Soccer, Tennis, Swimming (Cone Field House, Sparks Field, & Sparks Pool):** Take I-5 Exit 253 and drive west on Mission Ave. From the top of the overpass it is 2.2 miles to the Willamette University/City Center off-ramp. Once you take the off-ramp, you can see the Willamette soccer field and the Lestle J. Sparks Center. Follow the signs to Willamette and get into the right-hand lane at the light. Once you have progressed through the intersection, take the next available right onto campus. Volleyball, basketball and swimming events all take place in Sparks Center. The tennis courts are across the parking lot from the soccer field.
- **Golf: Creekside** is located in south Salem. From downtown, take Commercial Street south to Sunnyside, which forks to the right. Drive south on Sunnyside for 1 1/2 miles to get to the entrance of the golf course. **Illahe Hills Country Club** is located south of Salem. From downtown, take Commercial Street south to Owens Street and turn right. Owens curves left, turning into River Road South. Drive approximately five miles south. The entrance to Illahe is a few hundred yards past the blinking light at Roberts Store.
- **Rowing:** The Rowing teams have their own boathouse and dock located in West Salem off Edgewater Street. However, regattas are best viewed from Riverside Park near downtown Salem. The automobile entrance to the park is at the west end of Union Street. Parking is available in the park on the south side of the bridges.
- **Softball:** Take I-5 Exit 253 and drive west on Mission Ave. From the top of the overpass it is 2.2 miles to the Willamette University/City Center off-ramp. Once you take the off-ramp, turn right onto 12th Street. In 1/4 block turn right on Mill Street (right after train station) and then one block to 14th Street and turn right again. Enter the second gated parking lot.

Bus/Van Drop-Off

- **Football (McCulloch Stadium):** Team buses and equipment vans will park in the south end inside of the stadium. Parking will be on the grass area adjacent to the baseball batting cage and shot put ring.
- **Baseball, Track & Field, & Cross Country (McCulloch Stadium, Keene Stadium, Charles Bowles Track, & Bush Park):** Drop off on the right of the stadium entrance and park in the designated bus parking.



- **Basketball, Volleyball, Soccer, Tennis, Swimming (Cone Field House, Sparks Field, & Sparks Pool):** Drop off right in front of the Sparks building. Bus parking is in the most southern portion of the lot by the tennis courts.
- **Softball:** Drop off in the softball parking lot. Bus parking is in the back of the parking lot.

Locker Rooms

Football locker rooms are located in Keane Stadium (baseball complex). Visiting teams will use the concession area and the pitchers room.

Locker rooms will be provided for Volleyball, Basketball, Football, and Swimming. Locker rooms can be provided for soccer upon request to Skip Kenitzer at (503) 370-6257. If you have any other questions or concerns about locker rooms contact Skip as well.

Officials

Football Officials locker rooms are located under the football stadium seating area in Officials/Women's locker room. Access to this locker room is from the field side of the stadium.

Baseball Officials changing area is located in the pitchers room behind the visitors dugout in Keane Baseball Stadium. Basketball, Soccer and Volleyball Officials locker rooms are located in the men's and women's faculty/staff locker rooms in the main locker room in Sparks Center.

Media Relations

The sports information office is located on the second floor of the Sparks Center. The SID is Robert McKinney and you can contact him at (503) 370-6110. Football games have telephone jacks and wireless internet available for the visiting team in the press box. All other sporting events have wireless internet. For visiting teams, statistics will be available following each game.

Visitor Social Events

If you wish to hold a catered event before a game contact Bon Appetit and ask for Marc Marelich at (503) 370-6788. There is no tailgating inside the football stadium but if you would like to hold a tailgater in the football stadium parking lot you must. The City of Salem does not allow alcohol in Bush's Pasture Park unless they are in the one resolvable area in the park (the amphitheater). To reserve the amphitheater please contact the City of Salem at (503) 588-6261.

Sports Medicine/Athletic Training

Dear visiting athletic trainer(s) and teams,

On behalf of our sports medicine staff at Willamette University, we would like to welcome you to our campus for the 2010-2011 school year. Our athletic training room is located on the basement floor of the Sparks Center for Basketball, Volleyball, Soccer, Softball, Tennis, and Swimming. There is another athletic training room located under the McCulloch Stadium for Cross Country, Football, Track and Field, and Baseball.

The following amenities are available for your use in the Athletic Training Facility: ice, hydro collator, and ultrasound. Emergency equipment will also be provided. Please notify us if an athletic trainer will not be traveling with your team. We will be more than willing to help your athletes, although we require written permission for any special treatment protocols. Any taping supplies will also need to arrive with the team. Your bench will be provided with towels, water, cups, ice, and ice bags. Towels for showering WILL NOT be provided.

Should an injury be severe enough, the athlete will be transported to the Salem Hospital across the street from the University.

We hope that this information will be helpful with your plans for competition at Willamette University. The Athletic Training Facility will be open at least two hours prior to game time. If more time is needed, as well as any other assistance, do not hesitate to contact us.

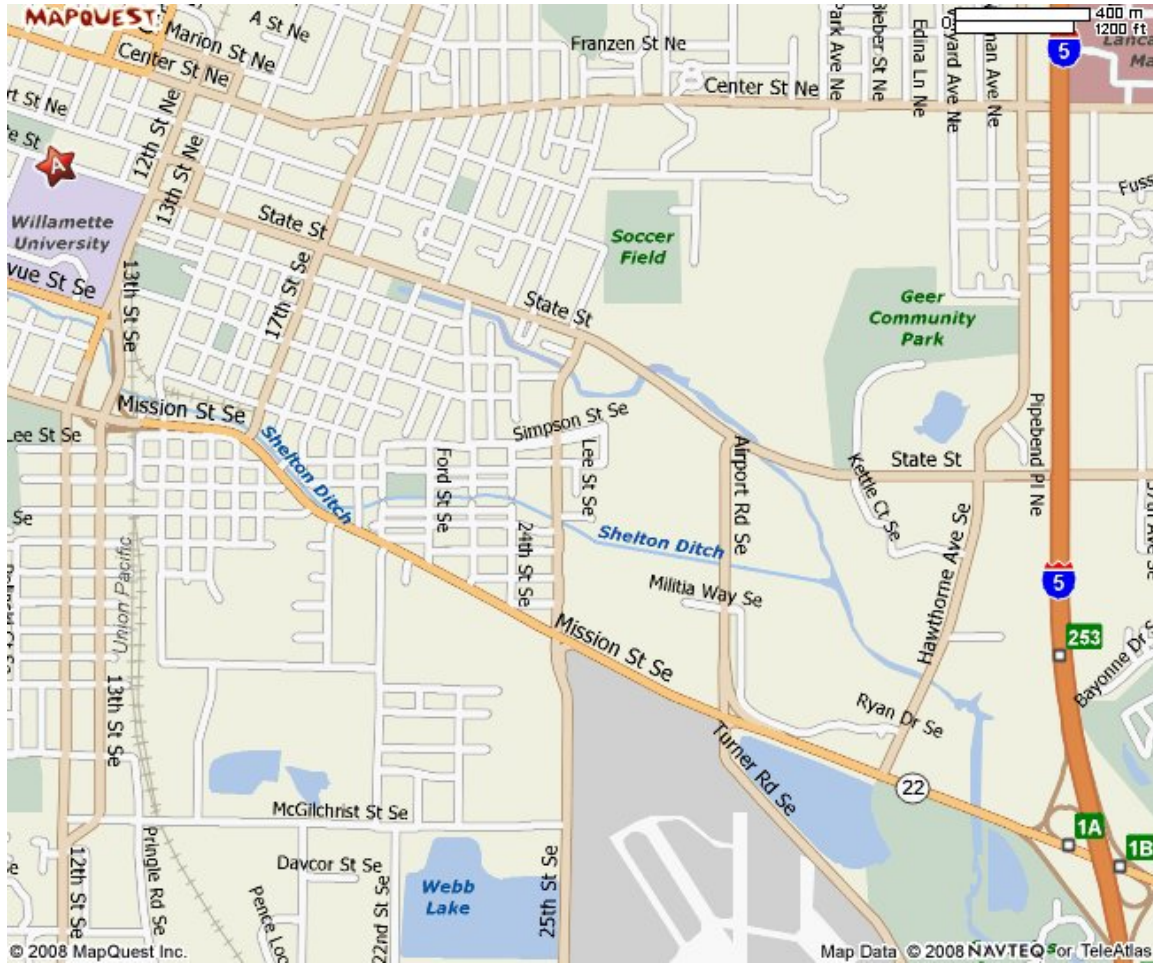

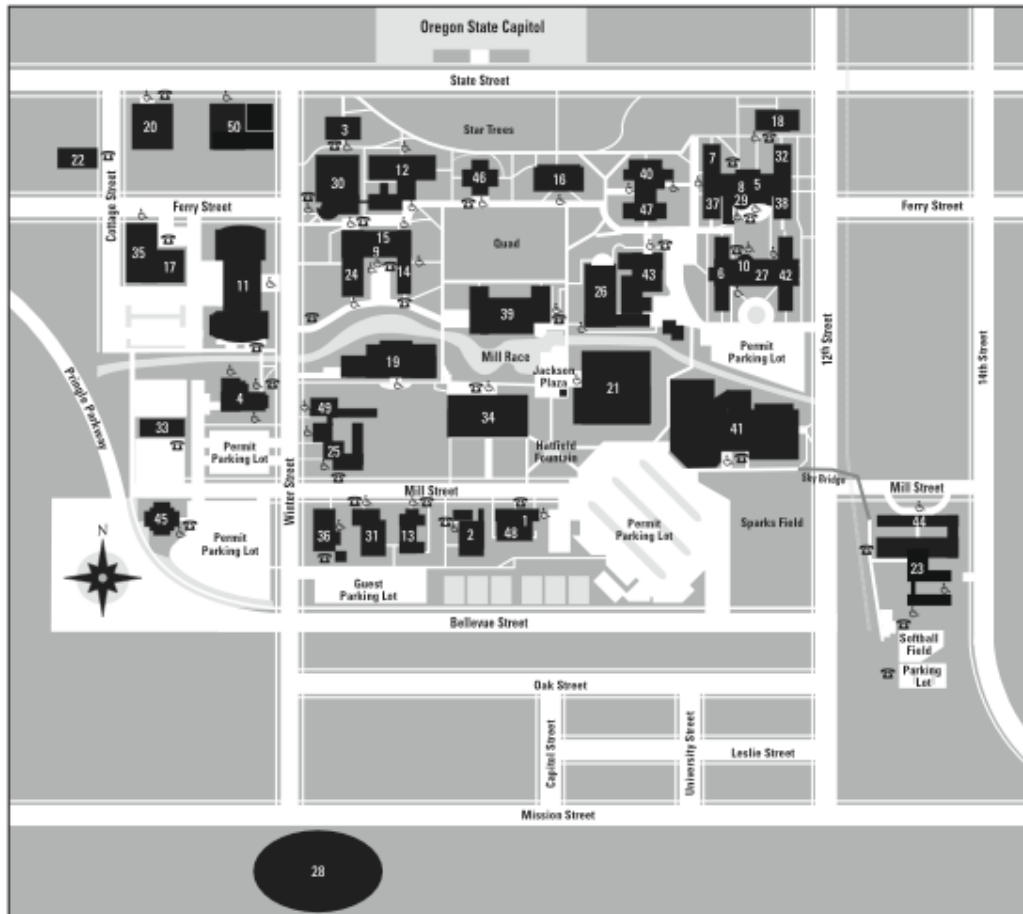
