- Prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place

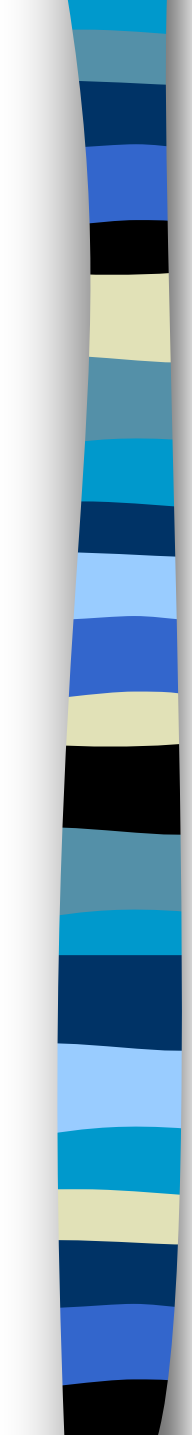
