KEY ISSUES IN PLANNING FOR A MAJOR IN PSYCHOLOGY

- To complete prerequisites on time, it's best to study abroad before the spring term of your junior year.
- To do a summer internship, you need to successfully complete PSYC 253 by the spring of your junior year.
- If you want to take an extra PSYC course, choose carefully. You are only allowed a total of 10 courses with the prefix PSYC to count toward the minimum 31 units to graduate. Units beyond 31 as well as units from PSYC 300, 498 & 499 do not count against your total.
