

Andy Aitkenhead Memorial Scholarship Rules and Guidelines for Application

HISTORY:

The Andy Aitkenhead Memorial Scholarship was established upon the death of Joy Aitkenhead in memory of Andy Aitkenhead. Its purpose is to provide awards, to qualified students, to be used for tuition and textbook expenses.

ELIGIBILITY:

The scholarship trustee will consider applications from students who:

- are a U.S. Citizen,
- are a science, mathematics, or engineering major,
- are a second year or above undergraduate student,
- are a full time student, and
- are in the top 10% of his/her college class based upon college GPA.

No preference will be given to any particular class of students and all students' qualification for an award shall be evaluated against the above criteria.

HOW TO APPLY:

Application forms are available between January 1st and March 1st annually by written request. Applications must be mailed and postmarked by **March 1st**, addressed to:
