The scholarship is for \$2,000 and is renewed for the senior year. The Mary L. Collins scholarship is merit-based and requires no financial need.

Candidates must have completed at least two years in residence at Willamette and must have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher. A campus committee will select recipients.
