UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Portland Alumnae Panhellenic is pleased to offer undergraduate scholarships (tuition only) for the 2006-2007 academic year. In recent years scholarships have ranged from \$500 to \$1750; award amounts vary according to availability of funds. Scholarship applications are available to active sorority members attending the following schools:

Linfield College
Oregon State University

Portland State University
University of Oregon

Willamette University

The purpose of the Portland Alumnae Panhellenic Undergraduate Scholarships is to assist collegians who are in need of financial assistance to complete their education. Awards are granted on the basis of financial need, scholarship, active participation in sorority life, campus activities and community service.

The applicant must be a full-time undergraduate student, a graduate of a high school in the Portland metropolitan area (Clackamas, Clark, Multnomah, or Washington Counties), and entering her junior or senior year in the fall of 2006. Under the terms of the scholarship, recipients must maintain full-time undergraduate status (as defined by the institution attended). There is no limit to the number of applicants from each sorority.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

ALL STEPS MUST BE FOLLOWED, OR APPLICANT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

1. Complete the attached 2006-2007 application form.
2. Include the following documents with your application:
 - a. Personal letter explaining your educational goals, interests, activities; and the nature of your financial need. This letter should help us get to know you.
 - b. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member.
 - c. Letter of recommendation from a sorority advisor, employer or an acquaintance who is not a relative.
 - d. Include a sealed official transcript with your application. Transcripts are confidential and will be returned to you if a self-addressed, stamped envelope is included.

NOTE: The two letters of recommendation must be in sealed envelopes with the signature of the author over the seal to protect confidentiality.

3. Place all papers and letters of recommendation in a lightweight folder with your name and the name of your college or university on the outside. Mail the packet to Jan Andersen, 17550 Brookhurst Drive, Lake Oswego, OR 97034. If desired, you may complete this process electronically. Send a request to Jan at jgandersen@att.net for the application to be sent to your email address. If you do email these items, please make a note when the recommendation letters and transcripts will be sent.

COMPLETED APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY APRIL 30, 2006

Failure to supply any of the required information will automatically disqualify a candidate. The award winner will be notified after May 31, 2006. The scholarship award will be sent to the business or financial aid office of the college or university of the recipient with instructions to disburse the funds for **tuition only**, divided equally between terms or semesters.
