



ISEP APPLICATION TIMELINE for Willamette University Sponsored Programs

Instructions: Students applying for ISEP placements in fall 2012 or an academic year look at blue notes - those applying for spring 2013 look at orange notes.

December 2 - WU study abroad applications due (all ISEP applicants must submit WU study abroad application)

December 6 through 16 - MANDATORY ISEP application information sessions for fall 2012 semester or 2012-2013 academic year applicants.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students applying for spring 2012 ISEP programs with *LIMITED PLACEMENT* may need to apply by the **fall** deadline – see ISEP's website for more information. This includes, but is not limited to, Ghana, Japan, Botswana, and Costa Rica.

January 24 – Fall 2012 ISEP applications due to OIE

Early March –WU Study Abroad Application results sent out via campus mail.

Mid March – The OIE will inform fall 2012 ISEP applicants of ISEP placements. **THIS IS NOT YOUR OFFICIAL ACCEPTANCE TO ISEP!** (Although it is a very good sign.) This is merely the second of three steps:

1. You are accepted by Willamette University.
2. You are placed by ISEP Central.
3. You are accepted by your host university.

Early April – MANDATORY ISEP application information sessions for spring 2013 semester applicants.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students applying for spring 2012 ISEP programs with *LIMITED PLACEMENT* may need to apply by the **fall** deadline – see ISEP's website for more information. This includes, but is not limited to, Ghana, Japan, Botswana, and Costa Rica

Late April – ISEP will confirm fall 2012 acceptance by your host institution.

Late May – Spring 2013 ISEP applications due to OIE (late May is a strongly recommended deadline, absolute deadline is mid-August).

Early October - The OIE will inform spring 2013 ISEP applicants of ISEP placements. **THIS IS NOT YOUR OFFICIAL ACCEPTANCE TO ISEP!** (Although it is a very good sign.) This is merely the second of three steps:

1. You are accepted by Willamette University.
2. You are placed by ISEP Central.
3. You are accepted by your host university.

Early November (at the latest) – ISEP will confirm spring 2013 acceptance by your host institution.
