

## **UTILITY MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATE PROGRAM**

### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS--IF YOU ARE COMMUTING TO WILLAMETTE UNIVERSITY'S PORTLAND CENTER**

#### **Where:**

Brew House & Tower Offices  
1120 NW Couch Street, Suite 450 (4<sup>th</sup> Floor)  
Portland, OR 97209  
(the street entrance to the building is on 1120 NW Couch, by Peet's Coffee)

#### **Directions:**

##### **From I-5 Northbound**

- 1) Start going North on I-5 N
- 2) Take the I-405 exit - EXIT 299B - on the LEFT toward CITY CENTER / US-26 W / BEAVERTON.
- 3) Merge onto I-405 N via EXIT 1A toward US-26 W / BEAVERTON / CITY CENTER.
- 4) Take EXIT 2B toward EVERETT ST
- 5) As you exit the highway ramp, move into the RIGHT LANE
- 6) Turn RIGHT onto NW EVERETT ST
- 7) Turn RIGHT onto NW 13TH AVE.
- 8) Turn LEFT onto NW COUCH ST.
- 9) End at 1120 NW Couch St, Portland, OR 97209

##### **From I-5 Southbound**

- 1) Start out going SOUTH on I-5 S
- 2) Merge onto I-405 S via EXIT 302B toward BEAVERTON / US-30 W / ST. HELENS.
- 3) Take the COUCH ST. exit- EXIT 2A- toward BURNSIDE ST
- 4) Turn LEFT onto NW COUCH ST.

5) End at 1120 NW Couch St Portland, OR 97209

## **Parking**

Validated parking is available for program participants not staying at a hotel. Staff at Willamette University's Portland Center will stamp your ticket from the parking garage located under the Brewery Blocks (PMC - Parking Management Company). The garage has two entrances, on NW 12th (around the corner from the building's street entrance) and NW 13th Avenues, between Couch & Davis. Both entrances are connected to the same parking facilities. Tip: If you enter the garage through the entrance on 12th, after you pass the booth/gate, turn right and go straight ahead all the way to the end. You will see elevators on your right that can take you to our 4<sup>th</sup> floor offices.

### **Parking Garage Hours (13th Ave Entrance)**

- Sunday through Thursday: 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday: 7:00 a.m. to 12:30 a.m.

### **Parking Garage Hours (12th Ave Entrance – BB4)**

- Sunday through Thursday: 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday: 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

The NW 12th Ave. garage entrance closes daily at 10 p.m. The only after hours exit is through the NW 13th Ave. entrance.

## **Public Transportation**

The building housing Willamette's Portland Center is part of the Brewery Blocks and is located on Portland's new Streetcar line and is close to mass transit. More information regarding the Streetcar line may be obtained at <http://www.portlandstreetcar.org>.

The MAX light rail is located at SW Morrison (west bound) and SW Yamhill (east bound) between SW 9th Avenue and SW 10th Avenue.

The Burnside Bus #20 can be accessed from Burnside and 12th Avenue going west and Burnside and 10th Avenue going east.

Fareless Square includes most of downtown Portland (within the boundaries of the Willamette River, NW Irving Street, and the I-405 freeway), as well as MAX stations from the Rose Quarter to Lloyd Center and bus stops along NE Multnomah to 13th Avenue. When boarding a bus, MAX or streetcar in Fareless Square, just take a seat. A fare is not required unless you are traveling outside of the Square. ## Coming from the Airport and staying at the Marriott City Center Hotel?

Taxi service is available to downtown, but a more economical option is the MAX Light Rail. Trains run every 5-15 minutes roughly between 4:30 a.m. and midnight. The trip downtown from the Portland International Airport on the Red Line takes about 40 minutes, and requires an all-zone fare of \$2.30. You can roll your luggage aboard. If you are staying at the Marriott City Center Hotel at 520 SW Broadway, get off MAX at the Pioneer Square North Max Station (Stop #8383) and walk a tenth of a mile north to the hotel.

From the hotel, it's about a seven-block walk to Willamette's Portland Center. The route in drawn in purple on the map below shows the driving directions taking the one-way streets into account, but you will notice that the walking route is shorter.
